## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Recorder of the Gardiner Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1911, c. 247, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 247 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended by chapter 74 of the private and special laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 11. Salary of recorder. The said recorder shall receive an annual salary of \$500 \$900, to commence on January 1, 1945 in full for all services 1955, and such fees as are allowed by the general law, and the same shall be payable quarterly from the treasury of the county of Kennebec, on the 1st days day of January, April, July and October.'
