STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of the Recorder of the South Portland Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1895, c. 242, § 23, Item VIII, amended. The last sentence of Item VIII of section 23 of chapter 242 of the private and special laws of 1895, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 157 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The recorder (South Portland Municipal Court) shall receive a salary of \$700 \$1,000 per year and \$600 annually additional for clerk hire.'
