STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of the Recorder of the Westbrook Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1909, c. 282, § 1, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 282 of the private and special laws of 1909, as amended by section 2 of chapter 95 of the private and special laws of 1945 and by chapter 167 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Such recorder shall receive an annual salary of \$500 and \$600 annually additional for clerk hire, in full for all services as such recorder, which salary shall be paid to him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of the county of Cumberland.'
