IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Construct Part of Route 9.

Part of Route No. 9, Androscoggin County, reconstructed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$70,000 to be used on Route No. 9, Androscoggin County, constructing about 5 miles, beginning at the junction of Route No. 9 and Route No. 136 and extending southerly on Route No. 9 to Bradbury Mountain State Park; said road to be constructed under the supervision of the State Highway Commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Route No. 9 is a through way from Durham to Webster and is a very heavily traveled road.
