IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Newry.

Sunday River road in Newry; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated, in favor of the town of Newry, the sum of \$1,200 from the general highway fund, to repair a section of Sunday River road, in said town.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Road was washed out in a flood and location of highway needs to be changed to prevent future washouts. Cost would be more than town could raise for the purpose. It is a continuation of a section of State Aid road and is used by residents and by many lumbering operators.
