IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of Brooksville, Hancock County.

Town of Brooksville; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$10,000 to construct 1.44 miles of the Cape Rosier Road, Hancock county, beginning at the southerly end of the State aid road and running southerly.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Cape Rosier road is the only means of road access to Cape Rosier which has a large tourist trade and is badly in need of further construction.
