STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Construct Portions of Pequawket Trail, Cumberland County.

Portions of Pequawket Trail constructed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the following sum to aid in constructing the following portion of State Highway 123 and State Route 113, being part of the Federal Aid Secondary System and designated as F. A. S. Route 123:

\$126,000 for highway located in Baldwin, Cumberland county, and beginning about 0.8 mile south from the Hiram town line and extending southeasterly a distance of about 2.8 miles to the junction of State Routes 5 and 113.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This section of the Pequawket Trail to be constructed is part of the Federal Aid Secondary System and the State's share is one-half the cost.

This section of the highway had a 1954 average daily traffic of 600 vehicles and to meet the needs of the traffic thereon should be constructed.
