AN ACT Relating to Age of Inland Fisheries and Game Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 29, sub-§ IV, amended. Subsection IV of section 29 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'IV. The Civil Service Commission is authorized to set the age limits within which original appointments to the warden service may be made, **but such age limit shall be not less than 40 years of age.'**
