RESOLVE, Relating to Daily Bag Limit in Red River Area Aroostook County.

Fishing in Red River area, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of not more than 5 fish in the aggregate from any or all of the waters in Red River area, located in T. 14, R. 8; T. 14, R. 9; T. 15, R. 9; Aroostook County.
