RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Waters Between Fish Lake and Round Pond, Aroostook County.

Fishing in Waters Between Fish Lake and Round Pond; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be and hereby is authorized to issue a rule and regulation closing the waters between Fish Lake and Round Pond, Aroostook county, to all fishing except fly fishing.
