STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Regulating Taking of Alewives from Dennysville River, Washington County.

Taking of Alewives from Dennysville River, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be and hereby is authorized to issue a rule and regulation granting to the municipal officers of the town of Meddybemps, Washington county, the right to issue permits and set the fees therefor to take alewives from Dennysville river, in that part located in the town of Meddybemps, under such terms, rules and regulations as said municipal officers may establish; and be it further

Resolved: That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to take any such alewives for market until he has obtained a permit to do so from the municipal officers of the town of Meddybemps.
