RESOLVE, in Favor of Flying Pond Improvement Association for Fish Screen.

Flying Pond Improvement Association, reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$778 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, to be paid to Flying Pond Improvement Association, of Mount Vernon, as part of the State's share of the cost of constructing fish screen at outlet of Flying Pond.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The 96th Legislature by chapter 96 of the Resolves of 1953 appropriated \$152.70 to the Association for the fish screen. The cost to the Association for the screen was \$2,270.80 and the purpose of the resolve is to reimburse the Association more fairly for the State's share.
