# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Increasing the Compensation of Aldermen of the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. V, § 9, amended. Section 9 of Article V of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended by chapter 16 of the private and special laws of 1945 and by section 1 of chapter 209 of the private and special laws of 1949, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 9. Compensation. The members of the board of aldermen shall receive as full compensation for the performance of their official duties as aldermen the sum of \$10 \$15 for each meeting of the city council which they shall attend provided that no alderman shall be paid an amount in excess of \$300 \$500 for such attendance during any 1 fiscal year. Members of the board of aldermen when they shall convene for the purpose of constituting a board of examiners in insanity cases shall receive as full compensation for such duties the sum of \$3 \$5 for each meeting attended.'
