STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Preference in State Purchases for Products Raised or Manufactured in State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 40-A, additional. Chapter 16 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 40-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 40-A. Products raised or manufactured in State. Where both bids and quality of goods are approximately the same, preference shall be given to products raised or manufactured in the State.'
