STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Fee for Licenses for Eating and Lodging Places, Recreational and Overnight Camps.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 162, amended. Section 162 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 162. License; terms and fees. The Department is empowered to license eating and lodging places, recreational and overnight camps. Such licenses shall be issued by the Department under such terms and conditions as it deems advisable, and fees for licenses not exceeding \$10 may be charged. The fees thus received shall constitute a permanent fund to carry out the provisions of sections 160 to 166, inclusive.'
