STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Recorder of Western Hancock Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1893, c. 613, § 3, amended. The 4th sentence of section 3 of chapter 613 of the private and special laws of 1893, as last amended by chapter 125 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Said recorder shall receive as compensation for his services an annual salary of **\$600 \$800**, to be paid quarterly from the treasury of the county of Hancock together with actual expenses incurred by him in the trial of criminal cases in any town other than that in which said recorder may reside.'
