STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Registration Certificates Under Aviation Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 24, § 13, sub-§ IV, ¶¶ B, C, F and G, amended. Paragraphs B, C, F and G of subsection IV of section 13 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes are hereby amended to read as follows:

'B. an aircraft registered under the laws of a foreign country and not engaged in air commerce within the State;

C. an aircraft not engaged in air commerce within the state which is owned by a nonresident and registered in another State, **otherwise qualified therein**;

F. an individual piloting any aircraft registered under the laws of a foreign country an not engaged in air commerce with the State;

G. a nonresident not engaged in air commerce and piloting aircraft in this State who is registered in another State, or otherwise qualified therein;'
