COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 378, L. D. 1074, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Regulation of Railroads by
Public Utilities Commission."

Amend said Bill by striking out all after the Enacting Clause and
inserting in place thereof the following:

" Minimum Distance for Clearance.

Sec. 80. Minimum distance for clearance. The Public Utilities
Commission shall have the right to prescribe a minimum distance
for clearance of any structure, pole or other object over or be-
side any railroad track; provided, however, that the provisions
of this section shall not apply to any structure, pole or other
object in existence over or beside any railrOad track on or before
September 1, 1955.' "
