## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Service Offices Established by Division of Veterans Affairs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 26, § 3, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 3 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - 'II. Cooperate with all national, state, county, municipal and private agencies in securing to veterans and their dependents the benefits provided by national, state and county laws, municipal ordinances or public and private social agencies; establish service offices in the several municipalities of the State or consolidate service offices to serve more than one municipality, and create a volunteer field force of workers who shall be accredited service officers of recognized veterans' organizations to man said offices; contribute to the expense of properly training and supervising such persons who shall not be in the classified service of the personnel law.'
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There shall be appropriated from the general fund to carry out the provisions of this act the sum of \$7,500 for the biennium ending June 30, 1957. Such funds shall not lapse June 30, 1956.
