**AN ACT Relating to Additional Contributions by Employers Under
Employment Security Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 17, sub-§ IV, ¶ G, additional. Subsection IV of section 17 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be lettered G, to read as follows:

'G. Notwithstanding any other inconsistent provision of law, any employer, who has been notified of his rate of contribution, as required by subparagraph 1 of paragraph F of this subsection, for the year commencing July 1, 1955 or for the year commencing July 1 thereafter, may voluntarily make payment of additional contributions, and, upon such payment, shall promptly receive a recomputation and renotification of his contribution rate for such year, including in the calculation the additional contributions so made. Any such additional contribution shall be made during the 10-day period following the date of the mailing to the employer of such notice of his contribution rate in any year, unless, for good cause, the time of payment has been extended by the Commission for not to exceed an additional 10 days.'
