AN ACT Prohibiting Dragging for Lobsters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 38, § 27-A, additional. Chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 27-A, to read as follows :

'Sec. 27-A. Dragging for lobsters, prohibited. It shall be unlawful to drag for lobsters within the territorial waters of the State. Any lobsters so taken shall be immediately liberated alive.'
