STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing for a Record of Veterans of World War II and Korean Campaign by Division of Veterans Affairs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 26, § 3, sub-§ V, additional. Section 3 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a subsection to be numbered V, to read as follows:
 - 'V. Establish and maintain a permanent record of all men from Maine who served in World War II and the Korean Campaign.'
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$6,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956 and \$6,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957 to carry out the purposes of this act. Such appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this act shall have been accomplished.
