STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Persons Committed to State Prison for Safekeeping.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 148, § 33, amended. The last sentence of section 33 of chapter 148 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following sentence enacted in place thereof:

'The county committing such person to the State Prison for safekeeping shall be liable to the State for the amount of the over-all inmate per capita cost per day based on previous year.'
