## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating of Trespass Upon Lands Appurtenant to Maine State Prison.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 131, § 37, amended. Section 37 of chapter 131 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 37. Trespass upon lands appurtenant to certain State institutions. Whoever willfully trespasses upon lands which belong to the State and are appurtenant to the Pownal State School, Reformatory for Women, Reformatory for Men, State School for Girls or, State School for Boys or the Maine State Prison, or whoever shall unlawfully interfere with the inmates of any of said institutions, or, after notice from an officer of any of said institutions to leave said lands, remains thereon, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 or by imprisonment for not more than 3 months.'
