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**AN ACT Relating to Legal Services for the State Highway Commission.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 23, § 3, amended.** The 7th sentence of section 3 of chapter 23 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following sentences enacted in place thereof:

**'The Commission may employ full time legal counsel. Such counsel shall act as legal advisor to the Commission in all matters affecting the Department, and shall give such legal services to the Department as are necessary. Any such counsel shall be ex officio an Assistant Attorney General and, by consent of the Attorney General, may represent the State in the several courts. The salary of such counsel shall be determined by the Commission.'**
