AN ACT Relating to Auto Travel for Inland Fish and Game Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 31, amended. The first sentence of section 31 of chapter 16 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The State shall pay for the use of privately owned automobiles for travel by employees of the State in the business of the State not more than 7c per mile for the first 5,000 miles actually travelled by such employees on such business in any 1 fiscal year, and 6c for each mile exceeding 5,000 miles; provided, however, that the State shall pay inspectors of seed potatoes 8c for every mile so travelled and the State shall pay Inland Fish and Game wardens 7c for every mile so travelled.'
