RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Dexter.

Town of Dexter; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$321.51 to be paid to the town of Dexter to reimburse them for aid given to Guy M. Lancaster.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1951 Dexter accepted the settlement of this man and furnished aid in 1951 in the amount of \$123.82 and in 1952 for \$197.69 making a total of \$321.51. From information the town of Dexter now has it is believed that Mr. Lancaster never had a Dexter settlement and Dexter paid for his supplies in error. The Division of General Relief has accepted him now as an unsettled person.
