HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" TO H. P. 979, L. D. 1127, Bill, "An Act Relating to Determination of Physical Disability by Department of Education."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of those parts designated "Sec. 202-A" and "Sec. 202-B" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sections:

ment. The State Board of Education is hereby designated as the State Agency to make determinations of disability required under Section 221 of Title II of the Federal Social Security Act as set forth in Section 106, Public Law 761, 83rd Congress, and the executive officer of the State Board of Education, subject to approval of the Governor, is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into an agreement on behalf of the State with the Secretary of Health, Education and Welfare to carry out the provisions of Title II of the Federal Social Security Act relating to the making of determinations of disability.

Sec. 202-B. Funds. The Treasurer of State is hereby authorized and directed to act as custodian of the moneys paid by the Federal Government to the State to carry out the agreement referred to in Section 202-A and shall disburse such moneys in accordance with the direction of the State Board of Education or its designated representatives."

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "Sec. 202-D" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined section:

"Sec. 202-D. Rules and regulations. The executive officer of the State Board of Education, subject to the approval of the State Board of Education, shall make such rules and regulations as he finds necessary or appropriate to the efficient administration of the duties imposed on the State Board of Education by the provisions of sections 202-A to 202-D, inclusive.'"
