STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Garland.

Town of Garland; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Garland the sum of \$1,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956 and \$1,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957 for repair and construction of road from Garland Village to Exeter Corner; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund. Any balance of the appropriation remaining unexpended at the end of the fiscal year shall be available for the same purpose in any succeeding fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road is in very bad condition. A State Aid road is being built there but it will not be ready for 4 years and the road needs immediate attention.
