STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Nonresident Fur Buyers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 125, amended. Section 125 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Nonresidents, licensed under the provisions of this section, shall not buy skins of any fur-bearing animals from trappers but only from licensed resident dealers.'
