STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Fisher.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ I, amended. The 6th paragraph of subsection I of section 113 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be no open season on fisher and sable, except that during the months of December, 1955 and December, 1956 there shall be an open season for trapping fisher.'
