SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 989, L.D. 1137, Resolve, Requesting
Judicial Council to Study Problem of Common
Law Pleading and Procedure.

Amend said Resolve by adding after the 1st paragraph thereof
the following:

'Resolved: That the Judicial Council be, and hereby is,
requested to study the procedural and jurisdictional problems
relating to bills of exceptions in both civil and criminal cases
with the end in view of eliminating the hardships on the party
aggrieved now prevalent under existing statutes; and \$2,000 is
hereby appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the gen-
eral fund to the Judicial Council to carry out the purposes of
this paragraph; and be it further'
