STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Requesting Judicial Council to Study Problem of Common Law Pleading and Procedure.

Common law pleading and procedure study. Resolved: That the Judicial Council, whose duties are prescribed by the provisions of section 195 of chapter 113 of the Revised Statutes, be and hereby is requested to study the problems of common law pleading and court procedure in Maine as they relate to the feasibility and desirability of substituting in Maine the procedure of Federal practice or that of the Code States, so called; and be it further

Resolved: That the Council report the results of its findings to the 98th Legislature.
