STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Amending the Maine Employment Security Law as to Weekly Benefits for Partial Unemployment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 13, sub-§ III, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of subsection III of section 13 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The individual's weekly earning class shall be determined by the wages earned by him during the week for which he claims a partial benefit as shown in column (B); except that remuneration paid or payable as holiday pay shall not be deemed wages for the purpose of this subsection.'
