## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Amending the Maine Employment Security Law as to Employers Experience Rating Record.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 29, § 17, sub-§ III, ¶ A, sub-¶¶ 1 and 2, repealed. Subparagraphs 1 and 2 of paragraph A of subsection III of section 17 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes are hereby repealed:
  - '4. Claimant's separation from his last employer was for misconduct in connection with his employment, or was voluntary without good cause attributable to such employer; or
  - Claimant has refused to accept reemployment in suitable work when offered by a previous employer, without good cause attributable to such employer; or'
