STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Weekly Benefit for Partial Unemployment Under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 29, § 13, sub-§ III, repealed and replaced. Subsection III of section 13 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
 - 'III. Weekly benefit for partial unemployment. On and after April 1, 1955, each eligible individual who is partially unemployed in any week shall be paid with respect to such week a partial benefit in an amount equal to his weekly benefit amount less that part of his earnings paid or payable to him with respect to such week which is in excess of \$3 plus any fraction of a dollar; except that remuneration paid or payable as holiday pay shall be deemed wages for the purpose of this subsection.'
