# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

## AN ACT Relating to Salesmen under Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 60, amended. The first paragraph of section 60 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All concerns selling liquor in and to the State shall furnish to the Commission a list of all officers and directors, if a corporation, or a list of all partners, if a partnership, and also the name of the salesman representing the concern within the State.'
