STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Officially Naming Echo Lake, Penobscot County.

Echo Lake named. Resolved: That a body of water of about one hundred sixty-five acres in area situated in the southeasterly corner of the town of Dexter, Penobscot County, and about one and one-half miles from the town, formerly known at Towle's Pond, Puffers' Pond, Spooners' Pond and diverse other names in past years, be hereafter officially named and referred to as Echo Lake.
