RESOLVE, Authorizing Forest Commissioner to Sell Island in Parker Pond, Kennebec County.

Forest Commissioner authorized to sell Island in Parker Pond. Resolved: That the Forest Commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Harold A. Huettner, of Hicksville, New York, for such sum as the Forest Commissioner deems just, whatever interest the State has in the island located in the easterly part of Parker Pond in Kennebec County.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The island is not being used at the present time and has no apparent value to the State.
