STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Exempting Insecticides, Fungicides, Etc. from Sales and Use Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 17, § 10, sub-§ VII-A, additional. Section 10 of chapter 17 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection VII-A, to read as follows:
 - 'VII-A. Insecticides, fungicides, weed killers and defoliants. Sales of insecticides, fungicides, weed killers and defoliants.'
