STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Salary of the Recorder and Clerk Hire of the Lewiston
Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1907, c. 444, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 444 of the private and special laws of 1907, as amended by section 2 of chapter 132 and by chapter 143, both of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1. Recorder; compensation, fees paid quarterly to county of Androscoggin. The recorder of the municipal court for the city of Lewiston shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$2,600~~ \$2,900 with ~~\$2,400~~ \$2,600 additional for clerk hire from the treasurer of the county of Androscoggin in weekly payments, which sum shall be in full compensation for the performance of all duties required of said recorder by law. He shall account quarterly under oath, to wit, on the 1st days of January, April, July and October of each year to the treasurer of the county of Androscoggin for all fees received by him or payable to him by virtue of his office, specifying the items, and shall pay the whole amount of the same to the treasurer of the county of Androscoggin quarterly on the days aforesaid.'
