RESOLVE, in Favor of Jim Adams, Inc., of Bangor.

Jim Adams, Inc., reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$40,400 to be paid to Jim Adams, Inc., of Bangor, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for loss of business in the construction of the Bangor-Brewer Bridge.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Jim Adams, Inc., is the agency for Nash automobiles in Bangor, and during the construction of the Bangor-Brewer Bridge access to his place of business was hindered to an extent resulting in great loss of business.
