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**AN ACT Relating to Discharge in Bankruptcy Re Financial Responsibility  
Law.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 77, sub-§ VI, amended.** The last sentence of subsection VI of section 77 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'A discharge in bankruptcy shall not relieve the judgment debtor from any of the requirements of sections 75 to 82, inclusive, **except that 10 years after the date thereof a discharge in bankruptcy shall relieve the judgment debtor from any of the requirements of sections 75 to 82, inclusive.**'
