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**AN ACT Increasing Salary of Adjutant General.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 14, § 11, amended.** The 5th paragraph from the end of section 11 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The Adjutant General shall receive a annual salary of ~~\$7,000~~ \$9,500; he shall receive no other fee, emolument or perquisite.'
