RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of Mariaville, Hancock County.

Town of Mariaville; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund, the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956, to be used on Route #181, constructing about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile, beginning at Amherst town line and extending southerly to 1954 State Aid Road construction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is the connecting road from Ellsworth to Amherst and is the mail route. Also, used by many summer residents. Road is in poor condition.
