AN ACT Relating to Moving Motor Vehicles Seized on Attachment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 16, sub-§ I, ¶ F, additional. Subsection I of section 16 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, to be lettered F, to read as follows:

'F. Any deputy sheriff with a writ of attachment may move the attached motor vehicle to the place of storage without registration or without any permit from the Secretary of State, provided that the sheriff of the county has a blanket insurance coverage for protection under the provisions of the financial responsibility law.'
