STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Change of Purposes of Domestic Mutual Insurance Companies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 60, § 33, amended. The 4th sentence of section 33 of chapter 60 of the revised statues is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Any such mutual company which changes its purposes to include the writing of any class or kind of insurance other than fire, marine or glass either shall have been doing business for a period of not less than 20 years, have admitted assets of not less than \$125,000 and a surplus of not less than \$50,000, or shall have a guaranty capital of not less than \$100,000 divided into shares of \$100 each, and no policy shall be issued until 1/4 at least of its guaranty capital has been paid in, in cash, and invested as provided in section 71.'
