STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Deer in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 91, amended. The first two paragraphs of section 91 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes are hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be an annual open season on deer during the month of November in each calendar year in the counties of Androscoggin, Cumberland, Hancock, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Oxford Sagadahoc, Waldo, Washington, and York and that portion of Oxford county south of the Androscoggin River. All the rest of the calendar year before and after the open season shall be a closed season on deer.

There shall be an open season on deer in each calendar year beginning the 21st day of October and ending the 30th day of November, both dates inclusive, in the counties of Aroostook, Penobscot, Somerset, Piscataquis, and Franklin and that portion of Oxford county north of the Androscoggin River. All the rest of the calendar year, either before or after the open season, shall be a closed season on deer in these counties.'
