IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Legislative Research Committee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 10, § 24, amended. Section 24 of chapter 10 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 24. Legislative research committee; membership. A Legislative Research Committee, as heretofore established, shall consist of 3 7 Senators to be appointed by the President of the Senate, and 7 representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives during each regular session. The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall be members ex officio. The Committee shall elect a chairman who shall serve as such at the pleasure of the Committee.'
