AN ACT Relating to Disposition of County Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 256, repealed and replaced. Section 256 of chapter 89 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 256. Fees. All fees of whatever nature and charges for the publication of notices required by law, which may be payable to any county officer, shall be payable to the treasurer of the particular county for the use and benefit of such county.'
